Subject: Debris Removal in Guilford County

Marty:

To follow up to our conversation pertaining to the debris removal operations in Guilford County, I am pleased to advise you that we have awarded the contracts and will begin the debris removal in Guilford County this Monday morning, March 31.

We have awarded two debris removal contracts in Guilford County, one for the eastern side, and one for the western side, and we will have 16 crews spread throughout Guilford County on Monday, with the majority of these crews located in southern Guilford County, since this area had the most damage from the March 6-7 ice storm.

We will be aggressively pursuing this debris removal from the State maintained roads, however, with the amount of debris that is on our Right of Way, and when you include the debris that is being carried to the shoulder of the road by the adjacent property owner, it will take us several weeks to complete this operation.

However, the operation that will begin on Monday will be our first "sweep" of this debris removal, and we will be performing a second "sweep" in order to provide additional time for the property owners to bring this vegetative debris to the shoulder of the State maintained roads.

If you receive a call from the public pertaining to the schedule, or if you receive a complaint about some debris being in the road, or creating any other issues, please have them call either Antoine White, County Maintenance Engineer, Camp Burton Maintenance facility in McLeansville, at 336-375-5475, or Tyler Berrier, County Maintenance Engineer, Sandy Ridge Maintenance facility near High Point, at 336-668-2464.
